GIANT HYSSOP

Agastache Mexicana



- Common name is Mexican giant Hyssop.
- It is a perennial.
- Grows to reach 50 – 60cm high.
- It has purple spiked flowers.
- It is necessary for the seed to pass a cold and humid season which break dormancy in order to produce germination.
- Requires direct sunlight or partial shade.
- It can produce flowers when it reaches 1 month old.
- Sunny days and cooler nights will produce a more intense aroma in the leaves.
- Its young leaves are used in flavouring foods.

Approximately 2700 seeds per gram
