## **ALPINIA CAERULEA**

***Native Ginger***



- An Australian Native ginger.
- A clumping plant with upright arching stems to 2 m
- Small white flowers on the stem ends which are followed by blue fruits
- The fruits can be easily opened and the pith around the seeds eaten, it has a refreshing lemon taste.
- This is a good plant for shaded areas and indoor use forming a clump and has large glossy leaves rising on fleshy stems to around 1.5 metres high.
- This plant prefers warm regions and ample water in dry times
- It's a very hardy plant when given some water, shade and protection from wind and extreme conditions.
