ANGELICA PACHYCARPA *Angelica Pachycarpa*



- This variety is a biennial.
- Grows to reach around 1 meter in height.
- Very glossy dark green foliage.
- It has creamy – white to greenish – white flowers.
- Flowers in spring in the second year.
- Is used as an ornamental variety.
- Sow in garden.
- Best planted at soil temperatures between 10°C and 25°C.
- Prefers moist, rich soil that is slightly acid.
- Prefers partial shade.
- Harvest is 18 months.
- Will self seed.
- Not suitable for medicinal purposes.
