## **ASPARAGUS**

*Asparagus Officinalis*

**Mary Washington** – Early long straight medium dark green spears with tight purpling tips. Requires full sun light. Planting time is spring. Time of harvest is between 60 – 90 days. Plants take time to establish, they can produce up to 20 years. Requires a well drained soil. Water frequently. It takes 14 – 21 days to germinate.

Aprox. 68 seeds per gram

**UC157 F2** – This is open pollinated. Large spears are non – stringy and if cut at the right time has a tender flavour. Sow 12 – 18cm deep with a spacing of 35cm apart. Harvest when spears are 10 – 20cm tall by breaking off at soil level.

Aprox. 55 seeds per gram
