

THAI BASIL

Ocimum basilicum

Siam Queen (large leaved) - Large vigorous bushy plant. Lush green leaves contrast with square, purple stems and deep purple flowers. Late flowering, resulting in higher herb yields. The spicy aroma is a cross between cinnamon and aniseed basil. Needs warm growing conditions. By pinching the centres of the primary and secondary shoots, many side branches will develop, which in turn will produce shoots with fragrant leaves.

Aprox. 650 seeds per gram

Thai Queenette (small leaved) - Decorative basil with small olive-green/purplish leaves. Stems are red, flowers purple. Needs warm growing conditions. Aniseed in scent and flavour. A special basil used as a vegetable in curries and spicy dishes.
