BERGAMOT

Citriodora – This variety has lavender flowers with a strong fragrance. It is lemon scented. This plant can grow between 60cm and 1m high. This variety is easy to grow. Best grown in cool climates with sunny location, can tolerate partial shade. Sow seeds in spring. Not suitable for growing indoors. Make sure that the soil is rich, light and moist. The colourful flowers attract bees and butterflies. Bergamot Citriodora is also known as Bee Balm.

Aprox. 2000 seeds per gram

Didyma – This variety have bright scarlet flowers and oval, toothed, hairy, aromatic leaves. The flowers are rich in nectar and attracts bees and butterflies. It prefers the sun but can tolerate the shade as long as the soil remains damp. Best grown in cool climates with sunny locations. Make sure to water regularly. Sow in spring with a spacing of 45cm apart. Bergamot is not suitable to be grown inside.

Aprox. 2000 seeds per gram
