## **BROCCOLI**

*Brassica Oleracea*

**Sprouting** – Broccoli is vigorous and easy to grow. It likes a rich and well drained soil. Sow in between late summer to late autumn. In colder areas sow in spring. Space plants 40cm apart. Keep soil moist at all times. Harvest while heads are still dark green, this is when its flavour is best.



**Romanesco** – This variety has waxy large grey green leaves. When the plant is starting to reach maturity it will form a single head about 20 – 30cm across. It requires cooler conditions to do well. It prefers a well drained soil. Romanesco can be seeded directly into soil. Allow enough space between seeds as they are fairly large plants they will need a fair amount of room to grow. This variety will be ready for harvesting four months after seeding, when the head has formed into a hard ball.
