BUCKWHEAT

Fagopyrum Esculentum



- It is a broadleaf plant native to Asia
- Seeds are brown in colour
- The seeds germinate and emerge rapidly when planted in warm soil, usually between 3 – 4 days.
- They will produce small heart shaped leaves with slender hollow stems.
- Flowering begins about 3 weeks after planting. This will proceed to flower until eventually tapering off as the plant matures.
- The flowers are generally white
- Plant height and speed of maturity depends on planting dates, depends on climate and area
- Buckwheat is not drought tolerant

Approximately 32 seeds per gram
