CABBAGE

Brassica

Early Jersey Wakefield – This variety is an excellent early type with dark green conical heads about 18cm long. Can be eaten raw or cooked. Sow indoors in early spring or outdoors mid spring. Transplant seedlings indoors after first pair of true leaves have developed. Plant cabbage in rich soil and water regularly. Germination is usually between 10 – 12 days. It takes approximately 70 days for cabbage to mature.

Red Sprouting – This variety can be used raw or cooked. Heads are deep red, globe shaped between 15 – 18 cm in diameter. Sow indoors in early spring. Transplant seedlings indoors after first pair of true leaves have developed. Space them 10 cm apart or in pots individually. Water plants regularly. Germination is usually between 7 – 10 days. This variety is easy to grow.
