

CATMINT
Nepeta Mussini



- Grows to reach 30 – 90cm high
- This variety has grey – green leaves that are coarse toothed
- The flowers are white, pale pink or purplish blue in colour. They are usually massed in spikes or whorls
- Catmint can be grown in most climates
- Prefers full sun to partial shade. The fragrance is stronger in the sunlight
- Most well drained soils are suitable but it does best in sandy loams
- Catmint self sows readily by seeding once it is established
- Requires plenty of water, keep plant moist at all times
- Pick fresh leaves as required
