

## **DILL**

*Anethum graveolens*



**Bouquet**

**Bouquet** – This is dark blue green aromatic plant. It is 5 to 8cm at leaf harvest and up to 16cm in full bloom. Leaf harvest may begin at 40 to 50 days and seed heads at 90 to 100 days. Dill needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. Dill will quite often self sow. Plant every fortnight to ensure that there is continuous cropping.



**Mammoth**

**Mammoth** – Grows taller than the Bouquet. Mammoth has sparser foliage and is green in colour. Begins seeding 5 to 8 days earlier than Bouquet. Needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. Needs to be protected from wind.



**Tetra**

**Tetra** – Has lush green foliage. Grows bushier and more vigorously than Bouquet, Delikat and Mammoth. Tetra is slow bolting. Needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. No particular damaging pests or diseases affect this plant.
