

DILL

Anethum graveolens



Bouquet

Bouquet – This is dark blue green aromatic plant. It is 5 to 8cm at leaf harvest and up to 16cm in full bloom. Leaf harvest may begin at 40 to 50 days and seed heads at 90 to 100 days. Dill needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. Dill will quite often self sow. Plant every fortnight to ensure that there is continuous cropping.



Mammoth

Mammoth – Grows taller than the Bouquet. Mammoth has sparser foliage and is green in colour. Begins seeding 5 to 8 days earlier than Bouquet. Needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. Needs to be protected from wind.



Tetra

Tetra – Has lush green foliage. Grows bushier and more vigorously than Bouquet, Delikat and Mammoth. Tetra is slow bolting. Needs a warm summer but can be grown in cooler regions that are frost free. No particular damaging pests or diseases affect this plant.
