

OREGANO

Origanum



Greek

Greek – This variety has sweet, spicy aromatic leaves and pink flowers. Grows to 23cm high. Prefers warm dry climates. Requires full sun or partial shade. Sow seeds outside in spring about 2 – 4 weeks after last frost. It is recommended to sow inside before last frost. This variety is great in containers. Keep plants well watered. Germination is usually between 5 – 10 days.



Onites

Onites – This variety has mid – green savoury flavoured leaves with white to pink flowers. Prefers a warm dry climate. Is not resistant to frost. Needs full sunlight or partial shade. Requires a well drained soil. Sow seeds in spring. Keep plants well watered and do not let soil dry out. Germination usually takes two weeks.



Vulgare

Vulgare – This variety has dark green peppery flavoured leaves with pink flowers. Grows to reach 60cm high. Prefers warm dry climates. Requires full sun with partial shade. Likes a well drained soil. Sow seeds in spring. Keep plants well watered. Leaves can be harvested in 85 – 95 days before flowers appear. Replace plants every couple of years.
