

ROSEMARY

Rosemarinus Officinalis



- This variety has a fragrance of pine
- The flowers are small lobed and are pale blue to pinkish
- Rosemary will grow to reach 50cm to 2m in height
- This variety is good to grow in containers
- Start plants indoors and transplant seedlings outdoors
- Cover seeds lightly after sowing
- Optimum soil temperature for germination is 60 degrees. Germination time is usually 14 – 21 days
- Sow heavily because Rosemary has a poor germination rate. Some seeds will germinate after 3 months of sowing
- Grows well in warm, dry climates
- Prefers full sun and a reasonably dry position
- Needs a well drained soil to lessen the risk of root rot
