

TANSY
Tanacetum vulgare



- Tansy usually has yellow flowers with no petals.
- When fully grown a Tansy plant may reach 6 foot.
- The leaves on the tansy plant have no stalk.
- The stem of the mature plant is a reddish-purple colour. It is mostly hairless with the branching clustering more towards the top portion of the stem.
- Most of the roots are near the surface of the ground. Tansy will re-grow from root fragments that have broken off.
- The seeds of the plant are the most common way that the tansy is spread.

Approx. 8,000 seeds per gram
