TOMATO COLLEGE CHALLENGER *Lycopersicon*



- Open pollinated
- Indeterminate
- Sets trusses of 6 – 10cm oblate fruit
- Mid season variety
- 7 – 14 days for germination.
- Plant in spring.
- Requires plenty of sunlight.
- Each year relocate your tomato plants in different parts of your garden to avoid diseases.
- Requires fertile slightly acid soil in a well drained location in the garden. Apply mulch, grass clippings or straw around base of plant.
- Harvest tomatoes when they are fully mature.
- Pick the fruit as they mature to encourage new fruit to form.



Approximately 412 seeds per gram
