## **TOMATO GERMAN JOHNSON** *Lycopersicon*



- Indeterminate.
- Heirloom variety.
- 80 days til maturity.
- Large pink – red fruits with meaty flesh and few seeds.
- Great for canning.
- 7 – 14 days for germination.
- Plant in spring.
- Requires plenty of sunlight.
- Each year relocate your tomato plants in different parts of your garden to avoid diseases.
- Requires fertile slightly acid soil in a well drained location in the garden. Apply mulch, grass clippings or straw around base of plant.
- Harvest tomatoes when they are fully mature.
- Pick the fruit as they mature to encourage new fruit to form.

Approximately 448 seeds per gram
