TOMATO ROMA *Lycopersicon*



- Determinate
- This tomato is oblong in shape
- They generally have thicker fruit wall
- Once Roma tomato plants are 6 – 12 inches high they will require staking up of the ground
- Easy to grow
- 7 – 14 days for germination.
- Plant in spring.
- Requires plenty of sunlight.
- Each year relocate your tomato plants in different parts of your garden to avoid diseases.
- Requires fertile slightly acid soil in a well drained location in the garden. Apply mulch, grass clippings or straw around base of plant.
- Harvest tomatoes when they are fully mature.
- Pick the fruit as they mature to encourage new fruit to form.

Approximately 440 seeds per gram
